

Data sheet of the exhibition « Tibet, 60 years of exile »



In 1959, the Dalai-Lama, followed by many compatriots, left Tibet to keep alive the culture of his people threatened by the Chinese regime. It was in India that he found refuge and organized a non-violent resistance. Thanks to an innovative educational system, democratization and the support of international organizations, the Tibetan community has managed to keep its culture alive for 60 years.

Through these photos taken by three Tibetan photojournalists, the NGO *Les Amis du Tibet, Luxembourg*, intends to shed light on the six decades of Tibetan exile in India by retracing the stories of three generations, their hopes and aspirations in a rapidly changing world.

This exhibition was realized in India in September 2020 by Tashi Tobgyal, Kasang Jigme and Tsering Topgyal, commissioned by *Les Amis du Tibet, Luxembourg*. The archival photographs are from the *Tibet Museum*.
